



## **Black Berry to iPhone Transfer Guide**

### **Gmail & Google Drive Backup**

1. If you have a **Gmail Account** that you could use for syncing, skip to the next step. If you do not have a **Gmail Account**, or would like to create a separate **Gmail Account** to keep files separate, go to [accounts.google.com](https://accounts.google.com) and create a **Gmail Account**.
2. Download Google Drive through the Black Berry App Store.
3. Once downloaded, sync everything you desire to move over to your new iPhone. **\*\*Please Note that Messages will not be imported to iPhone from Black Berry\*\***
4. Begin the basic set-up of your new iPhone. Once you have completed set-up, go to Settings – Accounts & Passwords – And Add a New Account. The Account you will be adding is the Gmail account you synced your content with. You will be able to sync Calendar, Contacts, & Notes through the mail app.
5. To gain access to the rest of your content you will need to download **Google Drive** from the **Apple App Store**.
6. Once **Google Drive** has been downloaded, open it and sign in with your **Gmail Account**.
7. Through **Google Drive**, you will be able to access your synced **Photos, Videos, & Media files**. **\*\*Note that the syncing process can take multiple hours to complete\*\***
